Dear Parents,

This term our theme is Explorers. We will be learning:

- Literacy stories with familiar settings. The Whales' Song. Story writing
- Numeracy -Multiplication and division; length and mass/weight; addition/subtraction fractions; position and direction; time
- Science- forces and materials; pushes and pulls; changing materials by applying a force; sorting and testing moving toys; comparative testing
- History finding out about the lives of famous people in the past (Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong); transport in the past; planning for a voyage
- Art/Design JW Turner, seascape paintings; make flying toys

<u>Homework</u>

Children should develop independent learning by carrying out tasks related to our topic. A list of possible tasks follows. Children are not expected to complete all of these, but should choose at least 2 to be completed by the end of term.

All children are expected to read at least 3 times a week as well as practising how to read <u>and spell</u> their "tricky words" (on the trucks), their "high frequency words" (on the keys) and their sounds (phoneme fans).
