Dear Parents,

This term our theme is "All Dressed Up". We will be learning:

- Literacy The story of Halibut Jackson
- Numeracy counting and place value; addition and subtraction; length weight and measure
- Science seasonal changes, clothes for different weather, properties of fabrics for waterproof/warm clothing
