Dear Parents,

I hope you all had an enjoyable Easter and that your children are ready for the new term ahead.

This term our topic theme is “Anglo Saxons”. We will be learning:

- Literacy – revision of grammar concepts, using dialogue to advance action in stories, non-chronological reports, Beowulf
- Numeracy – algebra, ratio, shape, money word problems
- Science – evolution and inheritance
- Topic (History) – studying the Anglo Saxons
- Art/Design – designing an interactive poster using electrical circuits
- Music – Drumming workshops, Recorders
- R.E – How do Christians decide how to live? ‘What would Jesus do?’
- PSHE – Healthy bodies, healthy minds – good to be me
- IT – Purple Mash Coding
- French – parts of the body, introducing ourselves
