In the morning pupils will explore...

The reindeers' noses get too cold when they're pulling Santa's sleigh. We need to make them some nose warmers. Which material should we use? Could you make something to go on the tips of their antlers too?	Santa mustn't wake up sleeping children, but his shoes keep making noisy footsteps. How can you help him by muffling the sound? How could you change his toe coverings for different parts of the world?	Santa's getting old and he's finding it hard to carry presents down chimneys. Would a pulley help him?

All the experiments will allow pupils in both key stages and those in EYFS to developing the skills of observing over time, pattern seeking, fair testing, exploring and problem solving.
