Dear Parents,

I am delighted to be teaching your children and we are looking forward to a busy, enjoyable term of learning.

This term our topic theme is “Weather”. We will be learning:

- Literacy –explanatory texts (newspapers) humorous verse and imaginative worlds narrative
- Numeracy – fractions, decimals and percentages, algebra and ratio

- Topic (Geography) – studying a range of extreme weather phenomena
