AUTUMN CENSUS

As you may be aware, each term, schools are required to send information regarding the school and their pupils to the Department of Education (census day). This term Census day is **Thursday 6th October**. Part of the information required is the number of Key Stage 1 children taking school lunch on Census day. This figure is used to allocate funding to the school for the Universal Infant Free School Meals.

We would like to ask you to encourage your child to have a school lunch on this day, if possible, as it will help the school financially. Menus will be sent home in book bags today and we will need them returned no later than Friday 30th September.

YEAR 6 SECONDARY TRANSFER

A reminder that the secondary school transfer application closing date is 31 October 2022. This is extremely important as any applications received after this date may not be processed until after 1 March 2023.

MATH SKILL

After the summer break it is common for children to suffer some loss in maths skills. In order to help your child regain lost skills please ensure that you check your child's KIRFs (On web) for this term and practise these.

For children in Year 2 and above, times tables should be practised as well as spending time on Mathletics each week. We will be conducting a parent's information evening about how to support your child in maths later this year and so keep a look out for this. Class teachers can answer any specific questions you may have about maths skills this term.

KS1 TOY MUSEUM WORKSHOP

We are delighted to inform you that on Monday 10th October we are taking our KS1 students, together with Bibury pupils to Bourton on the Water Toy Museum. They will participate in a workshop studying traditional toys and visit the local Museum.

HOLIDAY FREE SCHOOL MEALS SCHEME

This October half term, Gloucestershire County Council are providing vouchers to eligible families who have signed up to our Holiday Free School Meals (FSM) scheme. These vouchers are provided by Gloucestershire County Council as part of its commitment to 'no child goes hungry'. The vouchers are funded through grant funding we have received and is separate to that of the term time free school meals. The scheme is for children in reception to year 11 who receive benefits-related free school meals and attend a school in Gloucestershire. We are unable to consider college and sixth form students as well as children who receive universal free school meals, as they are not eligible for this scheme. Families who have signed up to the scheme will receive £15 per child, for the week half term. Parents who have signed up previously do not need to re-register, they will already have been included. To ensure we reach all those who are eligible, we are encouraging parents that have not previously signed up, to sign up as soon as they can.

For those parents who have already signed up, if more of their children have become entitled to free school meals since they applied, please ask them to contact us at <u>childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk</u> so we can update their account, as this not an automatic process.

Applications for Holiday Free School Meal Vouchers for the October half term period are now open until the 11 October. Voucher emails will be sent out on 19 October. Please encourage parents to also check their junk/spam email folders during this period as sometimes the vouchers end up there. If parents have not received their vouchers by the 19 October, please encourage them to get in contact with us by emailing <u>childrensfund@gloucestershire.gov.uk</u>.
