#### **CELEBRATION WORSHIP AND AWARDS**




Congratulations to all those pupils who achieved Star and Mathletics awards this term. They've all been working really hard. Well done!




# KIDS WITH BRICKS (LEGO CLUB)

We are delighted to welcome our pupils from the Ukraine. Thank you so much to Mrs Roberts, who has donated these books to help develop their language.


### WREN CLASS
