
How should we care for the world?

Key vocabulary

Unique	Not like anything else
Psalm	A religious song or poem from the bible
Creation story	The first story in the bible, where God creates the world.
charity	Giving help or money to those in need
Christian	Someone who believes in Jesus Christ and follows his teachings
Jew	A follower of the Jewish religion, Judaism
Tzedekah	This a word Jewish people use to show how they try to bring justice, often by giving to charity.
Tu B'shevat (also called TuBishvat)	The Jewish festival celebrating new year for trees.

Key Information that you should know by the end of the unit

- The Good Samaritan is a story told by Jesus to teach people how they should care for others.
- All world religions have rules showing that followers should care for others.
- Many Jewish homes have a Tzedekah box where they collect money to give to charity.
- People without religion also believe that we should take care of one another and of the world.

 - Trying to use less electricity
 - Walking or cycling rather than using cars
 - Planting trees
 - Picking up rubbish
