#### SPRING HOLIDAYS FSM VOUCHERS (HAF)

We would like to make you aware of the holiday Free School Meal (FSM) voucher scheme that Gloucestershire County Council is currently offering to families in Gloucestershire.

Applications for holiday FSM vouchers for the May Half Term 2025 will be open from midday 29 April until midday on 13 May. Voucher emails will be sent from week commencing 19 May.

Families who have signed up previously do not need to re-register for the May Half Term holiday vouchers - they will already have been included. Families that have previously signed up will need to contact us with any changes to their circumstances (e.g. if the number of children eligible increases or decreases). To ensure we reach all those who are eligible, we are encouraging parents that have not previously signed up, to sign up as soon as they can.

# WELLBEING FOCUS

#### The wellbeing strategy we are focusing on this term is the Lumi Nova App:

Just a quick reminder to revisit the gratitude jar, the breathing exercise and silver linings from the last three terms!

We will continue to explore these in school but sharing these at home will have much more impact.

The Lumi Nova App has been developed for children from 7-12 years old with symptoms of worries or anxiety. It uses a video game format to make the materials engaging and accessible. It is free and feedback has been very positive so give it a try!

#### Lumi Nova - Free for families in Gloucestershire — Lumi Nova: Tales of Courage

A reminder of why we are sharing strategies for supporting children's wellbeing.

So, what does anxiety look like? It doesn't look the same for everyone. Here are some ways in which your child might be showing their anxiety:

- Reluctance to separate from you (this can be mistaken for not wanting to attend school)
- Physical symptoms like headaches or stomach aches
- Moodiness and irritability
- Tantrums or meltdowns
- Trouble sleeping

#### What can you do?

- Make time to talk to your child.
- Listen to your child and accept that their worries are very real for them.
- It is important to explain that worries are normal and everybody has them from time to time.
- Try and get your child to spend less time on worries by creating a 'worry box' and arranging 'worry time'.
- Get your child to do something fun to distract them from their worries.
- Help your child to make a list of things that went right in their day to help them develop an optimistic outlook.
- Support your child to focus on what they can do, rather they what they can't do.
- Encouraging them to say 'I can' will promote more positive thinking
- Set aside a specific time to focus on your worries so you can reassure yourself you haven't forgotten to think about them.

As a small school, we know your child well and we usually notice when they need some time to talk things through. We welcome your support in recognising when your child is worried, so please let us know if your child is feeling anxious.
