Congratulations to Wren class who have won the attendance bear for the week commencing 11th September. Ernie will sit in Wren class this week.

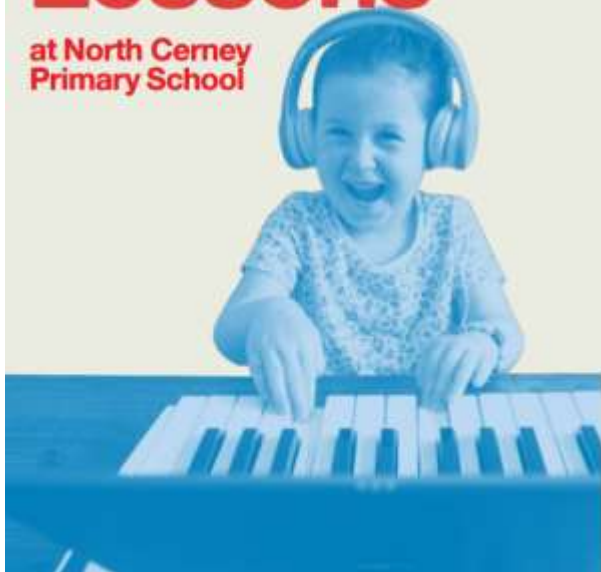
INDIVIDUAL MUSIC LESSONS
