Sukkot	The Jewish festival of harvest

Oil lamp	A light that comes from burning oil.
Miracle	Something that happens that should be impossible
Latke	Crispy potato pancakes eaten at Hanukkah
dreidl	A four-sided spinning top used as a game during Hanukkah
sukkah	A shelter built for the festival of Sukkot

Key Information that you should know by the end of the unit

- Judaism is the name of the religion followed by Jewish people.
- The story of David and Goliath is in the Old Testament of the bible and tells of David's bravery
- Jewish people celebrate different festivals through the year.
- Hannukah is a Jewish festival where Jewish people remember the victory of Judah the Maccabee and the miracle of the oil lamps that burned for 8 days.
- The Jewish harvest festival is called Sukkot. During Sukkot, Jewish families will put up a shelter in their garden where they eat all their meals.


