- Vocabulary is vital
- We have started using 'The Write Start'
- 3 part lesson – word collecting, modelling by teacher, child writing

# Reading

- Please read with your child each night and record this in your child's yellow reading record
- Books will be changed on a Friday and returned books will go into a quarantine box
- Accelerated reader and colour coded books to develop phonics and sight words.
- Please read to your child books that they could not read themselves. Research shows this is vital to later comprehension.
- Discuss new vocabulary
- Complete the weekly bookmark

# Homework

- Reading - this is the most important
- Spelling – a variety of words in families, common exception words and individual lists that your child has misspelt in written work
- Mathematics – again this will start soon and logins will be sent home when work has started to be set
- Knowledge organiser – this is a useful document to share with your child and discuss what they have learnt.
