- Please read to your child books that they could not read themselves. Research shows this is vital to later comprehension.
- Discuss new vocabulary
- Complete the weekly bookmark



Homework

- Reading this is the most important
- Spelling a variety of words in families, common exception words and individual lists that your child has misspelt in written work
- Mathletics again this will start soon and logins will be sent home when work has started to be set
- Knowledge organiser this is a useful document to share with your child and discuss what they have learnt.


