Choosing the right school for your child is extremely important. As a school, we are exceptionally proud of our pupils, our staff and our facilities and we are delighted to offer you the opportunity to attend one of our Open Mornings in July.

Our motto is "Striving for Excellence" and our 2022 examination results were excellent.

- 90% of Year 11 pupils achieved 5 or more standard passes (grades 9-4) at GCSE
- 83% of Year 11 pupils achieved 5 or more standard passes (grades 9-4), including English and Mathematics at GCSE

Open Mornings will take place during the school day, where you will be shown around by one of our Pupil Buddies. This will give you the opportunity to see the school in action, see how lessons are run and how well behaved our pupils are. You will also be able to meet Mrs Jo Lindley, who will be the new Headteacher from September 2023 and who I believe will be an excellent leader and a valuable asset to Kingshill.

Mrs Lindley will present a brief welcome speech in the Dining Room at the beginning of the mornings. We anticipate that the tour will last approximately an hour. Our Pupil Buddies will then return you to the Dining Room, where refreshments will be available and members of our Senior Leadership Team will be on hand to answer any questions you may have.

Parking will be available on the day inside the main school carpark and at the council carpark at Watermoor Primary, next to Kingshill School. Members of our site team will be on hand to help guide you with parking. There will be access from the council carpark into the school via the side gate.
