### English

This term we will be writing:

Explanation texts about how a robot dog works.

Whilst working through these topics we will be focusing on the following:

Writing with accurate use of full stops, capital letters, commas, question marks and exclamation marks.

In reading comprehension, we will be studying poems, non-fiction texts and stories linked to other areas of the curriculum.

### Maths

Year 3s will be learning about:

Measuring and Comparing Mass

Measuring and Comparing Capacity

Money

Year 4s will cover all the above topics and also:

Tenths and Hundredths as Decimals

Dividing by 10 and 100

Writing, Comparing, and Ordering Decimals

As well as our work on new units in maths, we will also be working on our KIRFs for this term and also recapping those from last term.

### Science

This term in science we will be looking at living things and their habitats. We will be asking:



Why do different animals adopt different habitats?

How are different animals adapted to suit their habitat?



## RE

In RE we will be asking "what kind of world did Jesus want?"

## PE

Mr Peters will be focusing on cricket and lacrosse.

## History

This term we will be exploring our local area and asking why should we preserve our locality?



## French

During this term we will be learning how to have simple conversations including how to say our names and how we are feeling. We will also be recapping colours and numbers!

## Computing

In computing we will be learning how to create a logo as well as investigating different hardware.

## Art

This term in art we will be looking at creating prints by exploring a range of artists including William Morris.

## Music

Kingfishers will be listening, appraising and composing music using Charanga.
