#### **HEAD'S UPDATE FROM THE PARENT FORUM**

#### Parent Forum Feedback

#### Arbor

Discussed issues with transition to the new system.

Parents wanted to know how to cancel bookings and how credit could be viewed.

- Admin will supply a statement to parents if requested.

#### Key Stage 2

Concerns that some homework is not related to work in class. Some confusion around spelling tests and practice routines.

- Mrs Pascoe to follow up with class teacher

Some concerns around behaviour

- Mrs Pascoe reassured parents that this was now under control

#### Religious visits

Discussion around what religious trips the school have done, normally based on the rolling curriculum. Visits have included Mosque, Rabbi, and Divali dance day.

#### **Trips**

Parents would like more cultural clubs such as pantomimes and circus.

- Mrs Pascoe said that a 'passport' of activities we would like our children to experience had been created. This will be shared with NCSA to see how they could support.

A cultural event on the weekend for the school community led by the NCSA was recommended.

#### ASC and Clubs

Desire for more after school opportunities and lunch time clubs

- SBM confirmed we were planning more from next term.
- Mrs Pascoe explained that staffing clubs can be difficult and expensive.

Parents raised concerns about Friday ASC as there are issues around spaces, with children not getting in and it being the only afterschool childcare on Fridays.

It was agreed that Friday Sports club should be chargeable to make it accessible for parents who need childcare.
