LATERAL FLOW TESTING

Following the success of the asymptomatic testing programme (Lateral Flow Testing), it is vital to keep testing at home. We are asking parents to:

- Test twice a week at home (test kits can be ordered and delivered to your home via the link <u>https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests</u>
- Report results online as positive, negative or void via the link <u>https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result</u>. This information is critical in helping us to understand the prevalence of the virus across the country, especially now when we are hearing of an increase in cases due to new COVID-19 variants. When you register at the above link, you are able to create a login, which saves your details and makes the process quicker.

Please be reassured that all staff continue to test twice a week.

We would like to thank you for your support in this matter – we are very proud that we have not had any positive cases within the school. Let's continue to be vigilant and keep testing!
