PARENTS EVENING

Due to COVID-19 restrictions this year, we have been looking at ways in which we can safely run Parents Evening. The conclusion being the only safe way is for meetings to be conducted via a mixture of telephone and Zoom calls.

With the above in mind, meetings will take place on Monday 19th and Wednesday 21st October between 3:30-5:00pm for all classes. As we only have one dedicated phone line in school, Owl class meetings will all be via telephone. Wren and Kingfisher class will be Zoom calls (you will receive joining instructions once all slots have been confirmed).

You will receive a 10 minutes slot per child at an allocated time, with siblings being grouped into a double appointment where possible. If you are unable to make your allocated time or are unable to access Zoom, we ask you to get in touch with the school office as soon as possible. Please also be aware that due to the change in format this year, your time slot may need to be changed at late notice. We ask for your patience and flexibility in this matter.
